The SEC's public hearing on change of annual registration statement fee due date for listed companies.

The SEC is seeking public comment on proposal to amend due date of the annual registration statement fee.

Currently, listed companies are required to pay fee for annual registration statement to the SEC by 30<sup>th</sup> April.

However, the SEC found that listed companies need more time to prepare payment process and could not meet

the payment due date. Therefore, in order to facilitate listed companies, the SEC is considering to change the

payment due date from within 30<sup>th</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> May of every year.
