

SEC Public hearing on investigation power of the criminal offense in SEC supervision Act.

The SEC is seeking public comments on inquiry power of the criminal offense in SEC supervision Act. Especially impose of the SEC's competent official act of the inquiry officer like the inquiry officer in Thai Criminal Procedure Act.

The inquiry power has limited only The unfair securities trading offenses as insider trading, market manipulation and false inform, disseminate, or certify any statement or information. To amendment this law is reduction of the criminal cases process and prevent the crime in capital market.
